


My Journey with Arabic **Program Objectives:**


Prices include:

- Transportation as outlined in the program, including airport transfers to and from Queen Alia International Airport.
- Jordan entry visa fees (Visa), if arrival is in a group.
- Accommodation at the selected hotels in Amman, as specified in the program.
- Academic program, educational materials, classrooms, training workshops, and cultural visits.
- One-night stay in Wadi Rum with breakfast and dinner included (4x4 jeep tour not included).
- Three daily meals throughout the entire program.

 A tour escort during all excursions (tour guide).
- Travel health insurance for all participants (according to the approved coverage for medical treatment). Non-covered health issues are not included under the insurance policy.
- Special discount for the group leader.

Prices not include:

- × Airline tickets.
- Visa fees for entry into Jordan if the participant is arriving individually (not with the group).
- Personal expenses.
- Purchase of the Visit Jordan pass by participants in their home country, which allows free and easy access to tourist and historical sites in Jordan.
- ★ 4x4 jeep tour in Wadi Rum.
- ★ Entrance fees to tourist and historical sites, and entry fees for excursions (as clarified in the notes below).



- An additional fee of \$100 will be charged for private airport transfers (per vehicle) if transportation is arranged individually.
- Tourist site entrance fees: Students will be informed of applicable fees when needed, including the following:
 - Horse riding: 15\$ per person
 - Ajloun cable car: 12\$ per person.
- Participants are only required to pay for the entrance fees of the sites they actually visit or for the services they use.
- Participants will be provided with **health insurance coverage** for emergency medical cases during their stay in Jordan (according to policy terms).
- The above offer is based on a minimum of 20 participants.
- 6 Each participant's passport must be valid for at least six (6) months from the date of travel.
